Mission Update

International Care Network (ICN)

ICN mission is to help to rebuild the lives of asylum seekers and vulnerable migrants. We are a Christian charity and believe that we should 'welcome the stranger', working to help refugees and migrants from all faiths and backgrounds to rebuild their lives in the UK.

Trustees, Alison Orman and Pete Triplow, and all staff and volunteers at the charity, would like to thank you all for your continued support, without which there is much that the charity could not do.

The range of support that ICN gives to refugees and asylum seekers fleeing oppressive regimes in places such as Syria and Afghanistan is broad, from registering with doctors, to aiding understanding of 'how things here work', to assembling flatpack furniture. Homework clubs help children keep up in classrooms, and creches are run to enable mothers to go to English lessons. Of all the barriers to integration, language is probably the greatest. ICN runs a language school which delivered 607 lessons in 2025 and helped over 392 people improve their English. Alison will be telling us more about this vital work in the mission slot at both services on 3rd May.
