NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Canford Magna AV system update overview

- 1. The proposed system addresses the issues identified in the Statement of Need and updates the key elements of the system to modern capability. Where feasible existing items have been retained to ensure prudent use of church funds.
- 2. Four companies were invited to submit proposals against a technical requirements specification. Future Media have prepared a proposal that addresses the church's needs at an acceptable price. The diagram below summarises the revised system configuration.
- 3. Essential features of proposed update
- a. New digital audio mixer that provides increased music group capacity.
- b. The ability to provide tablet (iPad) application control via wireless giving basic audio control for small services.
- c. Additional speakers and amplifiers giving improved music coverage in the North and South Aisles, these re-use existing speakers owned by the church; plus new speakers in the Chancel South Aisle and to the rear Nave under the organ loft.
- d. New radio mics and receivers with associated antenna to give more reliable performance. This will provide replacement for our existing lapel belt packs but is sized to allow for the future purchase of a handheld microphone.
- e. Updated video distribution to High Definition HDMI standard to our existing monitors with new fibre optic cabling and an associated new video mixer, this will support considerable improvement to the image quality.
- f. New lap top cabling to ensure HDMI quality connection.
- g. Blu Ray player to replace existing DVD player that does not support the modern HDMI interface.
- h. The new capability is sized to allow for a future deaf signer monitor and CMC connection.
- 4. The following is being retained from the current capability
- a. The existing voice speakers as these were judged to give acceptable performance currently.
- b. One of our existing video cameras, the 2nd is incompatible with the new system and will need to be replaced. The cost for this does not form part of the Future Media proposal and will procured by the church.
- c. The deaf loop and amplifier.
- d. The video recorder.
- e. The CD player.
- f. The projector.
- g. The Nave music speakers, foldback speaker and sub-woofer speaker.
- 5. The changes will require the following work to install the updated capability
- a. Mounting additional speakers in the north and south aisles and under the organ loft. The aim is to make these as unobtrusive as possible with fixings onto the roof timbers.
- b. New LSHF cabling to the speakers that will follow established cable routes, typically along the top of the wall plate.
- c. Ditto for the fibre cabling to the monitors.
- d. We will be mounting a small antenna system on the wall in the organ loft with associated cabling for the radio mics.
- e. There will be a new a remote audio unit to be mounted in place of the existing stage box in the musician's area.
- f. There are no proposed changes to any of the electrical infrastructure.
- g. There will be new equipment in the existing equipment rack in the organ loft and the new audio and video mixers on the existing desk, neither of these are changing anything in terms of the look of the church. A separate small enclosure will be fitted on the wall in the organ loft to support the fibre optic distribution equipment.
